“Considerations of COVID-19 in School Aged Children in the Central Valley”

Dr. Carmela Sosa, Medical Director for Primary Care, Valley Children’s Hospital.

Dr. Sosa, a Fresno, California native, completed her undergraduate studies at the University of California, San Diego and her post-baccalaureate pre-medical coursework at California State University, Fresno, and earned her medical degree from Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine. Dr. Sosa has practiced pediatrics in both the urban and rural health settings – always focused on children with special health care needs and pediatric mental health. She joined Valley Children’s Charlie Mitchell Children’s Center in April 2012 to provide complex primary care to children of the Valley. Her roles expanded in 2016 to include Associate Program Director of the Valley Children’s Pediatric Residency Program, and again in 2019 to Medical Director of Valley Children’s Primary Care. Her passion for teaching and practicing patient and family-centered care has earned her several Valley Children’s recognition awards.

Dr. Sudhakar Reddivalam, Medical Director for Pulmonology, Valley Children’s Hospital. Dr. Sudhakar is Board certified in pulmonary diseases and pediatrics by the American Board of Pediatrics, and joined Valley Children’s in July 1991 and has worked with our Valley’s children for over 30 years. Dr. Sudhakar is an assistant professor at University of California, San Francisco-Fresno. An active researcher, he participates in cystic fibrosis and asthma studies. After graduating from Guntur Medical College in Guntur, India, Dr. Sudhakar completed an internship at the Government General Hospital in Guntur. He completed pediatric residencies at Guntur Medical College and Rutgers Medical School in New Brunswick, New Jersey. Dr. Sudhakar completed a fellowship in pulmonary medicine at Children’s Hospital National Medical Center in Washington, D.C.
