Description: Participants will receive a quick anatomy review of small and large intestines; learn the definition of ostomy vs stoma, the differences in indications for ostomy surgery for different age groups, three types of ostomies and two types of intestinal stomas, stoma assessment and care, and learn about the different ostomy products.
Objectives: Participants will be able to differentiate an ostomy vs a stoma; identify the two types of intestinal ostomies and three types of stomas; list clinical indications for ostomies for different age groups; identify different types of ostomy supplies and state their use; apply learned stoma care techniques to their practice.

Description: Dr. Fukushima, OD has been trained to uncover and address the little things that

can make a big difference in quality of vision. Poor vision skills can inhibit and distort foundations for learning, but they might not always appear as one might think. When addressed the results can be life changing. Dr. Fukushima, along with his daughter, Jocelyn Fukushima will also be sharing some exciting news and observations from their Light + Vision program they co-created to assist children on the Autism Spectrum.

Objectives: Participants will be able to identify commonly overlooked visual issues and learn simple techniques to help remediate some of these conditions. Participants will also learn about the Light + Vision Program and recent observations on ways to support learning for all learners including children on the Autism Spectrum.
