



Farm Camp Nurse

Cazadero, CA



Overview

Farm Camp is located 2.5 hours north of San Francisco in Sonoma County, CA nestled in the infamous redwood forest just a mile and a half from the Pacific Ocean. The health and safety of our campers and staff is a top priority and we hire two healthcare professionals (RNs, NPs or EMTs) each session to care for and manage the wellness of our camp and staff community. Duties include following medical protocols, updating and organizing camper and staff health records, giving medications and supplements, and providing care through our days at camp.

Details

1. All food and lodging is included. Camp Nurses are provided with private lodging (a large platform canvas tent with full size bed and dresser) as well as all meals. Meals are eaten in an outdoor patio and sourced from the farm as much as possible.
2. Nurses are given 2 days off per week. Pay depends on experience and starts at \$250/day for RNs, \$300/day for NPs.
3. Camper tuition work-trade is available if you have a camper aged 8-17 who is interested in attending camp. 1, 2 and 4 week sessions are available.

Specifications

Must be able to work in an outdoor camp setting. There are hills and uneven terrain throughout the site. Must be comfortable with animals and children. No smoking or substance use while on site of camp. California driver's license and own vehicle strongly preferred. Active CA nursing license required. This role reports to the Wellness Director who is available by phone but not always on-site.

Why Farm Camp:

Farm Camp offers a traditional summer camp experience on a real working farm. At a time when children are increasingly surrounded by smart phones, computers, television, our goal is to get campers outside, actively creating, playing and learning. Our camp is located on 500 lush acres of redwood trees, creeks, lakes, and rolling coastal foothills, 1.5 miles from the Pacific Ocean. We are nestled in beautiful Sonoma County, providing many opportunities to explore and appreciate the land. Campers play an integral role in caring for the animals and garden to help provide food for the camp, therefore bringing the freshest ingredients from the farm to the kitchen and ultimately, the table.

Since 1952, we have taught respect for and love of nature. At Farm Camp, we minimize the impact we have on the earth, practicing and teaching environmental sustainability. Our program focuses on promoting a positive self-image, encouraging friendships and community, and practicing a healthy lifestyle. Ultimately, our goal is to have these experiences, friendships and laughter stay with campers the rest of their lives.
